Hunters up Their Game at the Louisville Deer & Turkey Expo Prepare for Hunting Season with Tips, Seminars and New Technology

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (January 19, 2017) —Hunting technology and techniques are always improving. The Field & Stream and Outdoor Life Louisville Deer & Turkey Expo includes experts, exhibitors, seminars, new products and prizes – everything hunters need to prepare for a successful year.

Held Friday, Jan. 27 – Sunday, Jan. 29 this family-friendly expo features more than 130 exhibitors, with many offering products that are not available in retail stores. More than 30 seminars will cover different hunting topics, from turkey calls to deer hunting.

Activities include chainsaw carving, daily door prize drawings and indoor shooting ranges. Daily meet and greets are scheduled with Tyler Wood from Discovery Channel's show Moonshiners. Wood is an avid marksman, fisherman, country music artist and fourth generation Kentucky moonshiner.

Tickets are \$13 for adults for a one-day pass, \$12 for military (with a military ID), \$5 for children (ages 6-15), and free for hunter education graduates (with proof of completion), children under five and hunting education instructors. Additional coupons and discounts are available online. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle and \$20 per bus.

Expo hours are Friday, 2 - 9 p.m., Saturday, 9 a.m. - 7 p.m. and Sunday, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m.
