CARL CASPER CUSTOM AUTO SHOW BRINGS FAMOUS CLASSIC CARS TO THE KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

LOUISVILLE, KY (February 12, 2016) – Classic cars, celebrities and music will fill the halls of the Kentucky Exposition Center Friday, Feb. 19 – Sunday, Feb. 21 for the 53rd annual Carl Casper Custom Auto Show. This event highlights vintage and custom cars with a schedule full of activities.

This year's show will feature a music festival in Freedom Hall with different concerts each day. On Friday The Louisville Crashers will take the stage at 8:30 p.m., with Caribou playing at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday and finishing Sunday with The Monarchs at 3:30 p.m.

The Battle of the Voices, a singing competition hosted by 100.5MY FM, iHeart Radio and Radio Now 98.9, will be held in Freedom Hall. Competitors can enter online at <http://momsmusic.com/battle-of-the-voices-2016>. In addition to the singing competition, there will also be a Band Battle in Freedom Hall on Saturday, Feb. 20.

Low rider cars will compete in the Low Riders Nationals in Freedom Hall Friday and Saturday at 7:00 p.m., with finals taking place Sunday at 2:00 p.m.

Autograph sessions with celebrities are also available throughout the weekend. Meet-and-greets include Stacey David the Star of "Gearz," WWE Diva Charlotte, David Constock from "Street Outlaws" and Cincinnati Bengal's Cheerleaders Tina and Seazum.

More than 100 pinstripers will participate in the Pinstripers Charity Panel Jam Auction. Car pinstripers will paint everyday objects to be auctioned for charity. Many of the pieces will be created at the show and there are eight different auctions throughout the event.

Tickets are \$17 for adults, \$5 for children (6-12) and free for children five and under. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle. Show hours are Friday, 6:00 p.m. - 11:00 p.m., Saturday, 10:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m. and Sunday, 12:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

ABOUT PARKING

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major interstates, the Kentucky Exposition Center is easily accessible and just five minutes south of downtown Louisville. The spacious grounds have 19,000 parking spaces and is accessible from six gates surrounding the facility. Gates are located off of Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway.
