SHOW OF SHOWS BRINGS ANTIQUE FIREARMS AND VETERANS TO THE KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

LOUISVILLE, KY (February 24, 2014) – The 22nd Annual Show of Shows Antique Military Show brings historic military artifacts and veterans to the Kentucky Exposition Center Thursday, February 27 – Sunday, March 2.

More than 760 dealers are expected to display documents, books, uniforms and antique firearms. Visitors can also meet and talk with veterans representing various past wars, including Cpl. Ron Rosser, Korean War Medal of Honor Recipient; Vietnam War Medal of Honor Recipient Don Jenkins; and World War II Doolittle Raiders pilot Dick Cole.

On Thursday from 12:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. and Sunday until 12:00 p.m. the show is open only to Ohio Valley Military Society Members. Memberships can be purchased at the door and are \$40 for residents of the United States. The show is open to the public Friday 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. and Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Held in South Wing A and East Hall, admission is \$10 per day for adults or \$18 for a weekend pass. Children 18 and under are free. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle.
