WOMEN OF JOY TOUR BRINGS WORSHIP, SPEAKERS AND FELLOWSHIP TO FREEDOM HALL

LOUISVILLE, KY (April 3, 2014) – Thousands of women will congregate in Freedom Hall on Friday, April 11 – Sunday, April 13 for the annual Women of Joy traveling conference. Focusing on the spiritual needs of women, Women of Joy features concerts, worship and speakers.

Grammy Award-winner Chris Tomlin will headline the Saturday night concert. Best known for his hit worship songs, including “How Great is Our God” and “Holy Is The Lord,” Tomlin has been a mainstay in Christian music with 16 songs appearing on the Billboard’s Hot Christian Songs chart and five reaching the top spot. Since his debut in 2004, Tomlin has won 21 GMA Dove awards as well as a Grammy Award for Best Contemporary Christian Music Album. He will be joined in concert by Christy Nockels, who has been writing and recording Christian music since 1996.

The line-up of speakers includes Rachel Ramsey Cruze, the daughter of Dave Ramsey who will discuss debt and financial planning, former Mrs. United States Sheri Rose Shepherd, Nancy Stafford and popular Bible teacher and author Margaret Feinberg.

The door opens at 6:00 p.m. Friday with the main session beginning at 7:00 p.m. and continues on Saturday at 8:30 a.m. and Sunday 9:00 a.m. Tickets are \$109 per person or \$99 per person for groups of 10 or more. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle.
