15,000 Street Rods, Classics and Muscle Cars Roar into Kentucky Exposition Center

- WHAT** Street Rod Nationals returns to Louisville for the 23rd year, with up to 15,000 street rods, classics and muscle cars from the 50s, 60s and 70s. The vehicles roar into the Kentucky Exposition Center for the National Street Rod Association's 48th annual event, drawing an anticipated 70,000 visitors. The total value of street rods at Nationals is an estimated \$385 million dollars.
- The four-day event features a vintage auto parts swap meet and a tradeshow with more than 375 manufacturers and dealers displaying and selling parts, accessories and supplies – plus an arts and crafts fair.

One of the 10 largest facilities of its kind in the U.S., the [Kentucky Exposition Center](#) (KEC) features 1.2 million square feet of contiguous exhibit space, including Freedom Hall, an indoor arena that seats 13,500 people. The facility's class "A" exhibit space totals 677,000 square feet and accommodates a wide range of events year round. KEC is the permanent home of the Kentucky State Fair, National Farm Machinery Show and North American International Livestock Exposition. For more information, go to www.kyexpo.org.

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major interstates, KEC is easily accessible and just seven minutes south of downtown Louisville. Entrances to the facility are located off Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway. Parking is \$8 per vehicle and \$20 per bus.
