SERVICE MEMBERS HONORED DURING MILITARY MONDAY AT THE KENTUCKY STATE FAIR

LOUISVILLE, KY (August 15, 2014) – In honor of the United States Military, the Kentucky State Fair celebrates patrons who serve or have served our country. Military Monday on August 18 offers all active duty and veteran military and their family members half-off admission and \$10 midway wristbands. Valid military ID is required.

To kick off the special day, a ceremony will be held at 9 a.m. on the Kentucky Kingdom plaza with Kentucky Department of Veterans Affairs Commissioner Heather French Henry. Secretary of State Alison Lundergan Grimes will highlight the Military Heroes Voting Initiative.

Participating vendors on Military Monday will be offering various food discounts with military ID. Vendor booths will have signs denoting their participation.

Proof of service for Military Monday Discount includes all active duty Guard and Reserve current military ID cards, retired veterans ID card, VA medical card, DD Form 214, or a valid driver's license denoting you as a veteran. A membership card in any organization where membership is contingent upon military service, such as VFW, AMVETS, and AMERICAN LEGION are also proof of service.
