SAMOYED CLUB OF AMERICA NATIONAL SPECIALTY BRINGS COMPETITIVE CANINES TO THE KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

LOUISVILLE, KY (September 17, 2015) – Dogs from around the world will travel to Louisville to compete in the Samoyed Club of America National Specialty Tuesday, Sept. 22 - Saturday, Sept. 26 at the Kentucky Exposition Center.

This national specialty show for the Samoyed breed brings dogs and owners from across the country and international competitors from Australia, England, Scotland and Canada to Louisville to compete in a variety of dog show competitions including rally, conformation and weight pulling culminating in a Best of Breed competition on Saturday. More than 400 dogs will compete at the event.

One of the oldest breeds in the world, Samoyed dogs are known for their striking white coat and friendly disposition. The Samoyed breed traces its roots to Northern Siberia, where Samoyeds were bred for a variety of tasks including pulling sleds, hunting, babysitting and herding reindeer.

Competition runs Tuesday, 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. and Wednesday - Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. each day in the West Wing. This event is free and open to the public.

ABOUT PARKING

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major interstates, the Kentucky Exposition Center is easily accessible and just five minutes south of downtown Louisville. The spacious grounds have 19,000 parking spaces and is accessible from six gates surrounding the facility. Gates are located off of Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle and \$20 per bus.
