LOUISVILLE, KY (September 26, 2014) – The Q Fest Louisville brings some of the best country music acts to Freedom Hall on Saturday, October 5 at 7:00 p.m. The star-studded lineup includes Justin Moore, Thomas Rhett, Parmalee, RaeLynn and Dee Jay Silver.

Country star Justin Moore has released three albums and charted eight songs on the Hot Country Songs charts including No. 1 hits “Small Town USA,” “If Heaven Wasn’t So Far Away” and “Til My Last Day.”

Thomas Rhett has charted five singles from his debut album including the title track “It Goes Like This.” Parmalee, best known for “Carolina” which reached No. 1 on the US Country Airplay chart will also perform. In addition, RaeLynn from the second season of NBC’s The Voice, who just released her first radio single “God Made Girls” in July, completes the lineup.

New Country Q103.1 is producing the concert as a party for their listeners.

“This won’t just be another concert. This will be an experience, complete with Dee Jay Silver keeping the music going between sets and lots of interactive elements for the crowd,” said WQNU Operations Manager and afternoon host Shane Collins.
