NATIONAL RECREATION VEHICLE INDUSTRY ASSOCIATION RETURNS TO THE KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

LOUISVILLE, KY (November 24, 2015) – The 53rd Annual National Recreation Vehicle Industry Association Trade Show returns to Louisville Tuesday, Dec. 1 – Thursday, Dec. 3 at the Kentucky Exposition Center. This industry-only event draws approximately 7,500 attendees and is expected to generate \$6.6 million in economic impact.

The three-day show, produced annually by the Recreational Vehicle Industry Association, brings recreational vehicle dealers, distributors, campground operators and exhibitors together in one location to see the latest RV products. Sixty manufacturers and more than 230 suppliers will take up all 1.2 million square feet of space of the Kentucky Exposition Center. In addition to exhibits, the show will feature educational seminars that include hands-on technician training, information about sales and more.

The RV industry has seen six consecutive years of growth and the Louisville show offers the opportunity for the industry to see the latest products, network with colleagues and gain additional education.

ABOUT THE KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

One of the top 10 largest public facilities of its kind in the United States, the Kentucky Exposition Center features 1.2 million square feet of contiguous exhibit space including Freedom Hall, an indoor arena which seats over 19,000 people. The facility's class "A" exhibit space totals 677,000 square feet and accommodates an amazing spectrum of events year round. ABOUT PARKING

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major interstates, the Kentucky Exposition Center is easily accessible and just five minutes south of downtown Louisville. The spacious grounds have 19,000 parking spaces and is accessible from six gates surrounding the facility. Gates are located off of Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle and \$20 per bus.
